#### Candidates attend public forum

Eight candidates for the May 8 Salida Hospital District board of directors election spoke during a public forum Tuesday in Salida City Council Chambers.

About 35 people attended the two-hour event hosted by League of Women Voters of Chaffee County.

Candidates were given equal time for opening statements before answering queries from the audience about issues facing Heart of the Rockies Regional Medical Center.

Moderator Jacqueline Sobczak asked questions submitted by the audience about candidates': budgets and believes budgeting experience is important. He said the only way the hospital can keep offering services to the community is "if the hospital can afford it."

Joan Michaud, Salida, said knowledge of budgets is something candidates will learn once elected to the board.

Regarding the hospital's strategic plan, John Klein, Salida, said he would like to see integrated health care become a board priority. Klein said it is "very rare" when someone has a serious medical problem that they do not also have mental health concerns as well.

Hugh Young, Salida, returned to his campaign slogan of accountability, accessibility and affordability as priorities for the hospital. As a

#### Bouldin, Forster win

Voters in the Salida Hospital District election Tuesday chose Marilyn Bouldin and Charles Forster, both of Salida, to fill the two open board seats at the Heart of the Rockies Regional Medical Center.

Of the 2,111 votes cast for eight candidates in the election, Bouldin garnered 24.63 percent or 520 votes. Forster received 489 votes, or 23.16 Please see TURNOUT, back page
