The *Campaign's* vision: Everyone in America can live a healthier life, advanced by equity-minded nurses as essential and valued partners in providing care and promoting health equity and well-being.





We are working to:

- Foster and unleash the power of equity-minded nurses to lead and advocate for health equity and disrupt structural racism.
- Strengthen, grow, and diversify nursing at all levels.
- Increase equitable access to care by nurses.
- Strengthen, diversify, and engage the *Campaign* stakeholder network to implement recommendations from the *Future of Nursing 2020-2030: Charting a Path to Achieve Health Equity*.



Already, we have:

- Improved access to care in 13 states, so that now 94 million people in 26 states and the District of Columbia have direct access to nurse practitioners.
- Helped diversify the nursing workforce through mentor programs with Black, Hispanic and American Indian/Alaska Native schools of nursing to retain and graduate their students.
- Helped fill 10,000+ boards seats or decision-making bodies with nurses whose strategic influence will improve the health of communities.
- Developed a broad network of national and state coalitions that include businesses, health organizations, hospital systems, insurers, private companies, and non-profit organizations.
- Raised more than \$110 million in service of creating healthier communities through nursing.

Advancing nursing means advancing health equity.

As the largest and consistently most trusted profession in the health care workforce, nurses are well-suited to help our country advance health equity. Nurses are bridge builders and collaborators who engage and connect with people, communities, and organizations to ensure people from all backgrounds have what they need to be healthy and well.
